Condition		After installation of the GM Accessory Performance Brake Pads it may be noticed that the EBCM has set DTC(s) C116C sym05 and/or C116B sym05. There will be NO warning lights or messages displayed on the IPC/DIC.						
Cause		The GM Accessory Performance Brake Pads do not utilize the brake pad wear sensor.						

Correction:

None, the DTC(s) should be ignored. These DTC(s) do not cause any warning lights or messages to be displayed in the IPC/DIC. Per the GM Accessory Performance Brake installation instructions, the brake pad sensor connector should be capped with the supplied parts and the brake pad life system disabled in the DIC.

Note: The GM Accessory Performance brake pads still have built-in wear indicators that make a high-pitched warning sound when the brake pads are worn.
