

1. Remove housing cover from the mirror body.





2. Remove paint on the bottom of the tongue area on the housing cover.





3. Add clear tape (4mm x 0.5mm x 200mm) on top of the housing cover tongue in the area marked (black). Part number A1676980302 (gravel protection foil, made by 3M) would be suitable.





4. Reattach housing cover to the mirror body.



4. Verify tape can not be seen in the gap between the bezel and the housing cover.
