Subject: Front End Rattle Noise when Braking Moderate or Hard on Rough Surfaces

Additional Options (RPOs)	Equipped with Strut Assembly Chassis Equipment (RPO GNA)	
O and distant	Some customers may comment that when braking harder than normal on rougher road surfaces, they may hear a rattle/buzz type noise.	
Condition	⇒ The rattle/buzz noise would sound similar to an ABS activation, but is not related to the calipers, brake pads or the ABS.	
Cause	This may be due to the front suspension bushings coming into contact with internal metal components or bushing frame mounts.	
Correction	Replace both front lower control arms.	

#### **Service Procedure**

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, replace BOTH front lower control arms. Refer to *Lower Control Arm Replacement* in SI.
