WLG1 Workshop campaign – Replacing brake discs and brake pads on the front and rear axle

Overview

Due to a production error, the left/right brake discs on one axle were interchanged on the affected vehicles or the wrong brake discs were installed.

As a result, increased brake wear can occur due to high loading of the brake system, e.g. as occurs under race track use.

To prevent this from happening, the brake discs and brake pads must be replaced on the relevant axles.
