WKL3 Workshop campaign - Replacing ball pins on rear lid

Overview

There is a possibility that the ball pins for securing the actuating cylinders for the rear lid will loosen from the body over the service life of the vehicle due to a manufacturing error.

This can cause the ball pins to break, resulting in unintentional lowering of the lid.

To prevent this from happening, the ball pins for securing the actuating cylinders for the rear lid to the body must be replaced.
