# DESCRIPTION

When performing vehicle services such as control unit sofware update, control unit registration/activation, CMU log data retrieval, etc., always use the GR8 battery charger SST to maintain battery voltage.

Set the GR8 to "Manual Mode".

- Set Voltage to 14.50 V
- Set Max Time to "CONTINUOUS"

#### CAUTION:

- DO NOT use the "Power Supply Mode." If the "Power Supply Mode" is used and the vehicle battery is low, the GR8 will switch from "Power Supply Mode" to "Diagnostic Mode." Diagnostic Mode 16V charging is too high for a module software update.
- If the vehicle battery is low, charge the battery and only perform a module software update when the GR8 is in "Manual Mode" at 14.50 V charging (see table below).
