I am have problems of correcting codes 2049-9 J-1939 message missing from address 49 and fault code 527-9 message is missing. The truck was towed in for a no crank problem and had code 625-2 CPC message not received. We follow t/s steps and found that the CPC was faulty by installing our test CPC(all fault codes where inactive with the test CPC). We installed a replacement CPC and updated all other modules and now we have code 2049-9 and 527-9 active. Since than we have reprogrammed all modules back to the OEM settings but we are still getting active codes 2049-9 and 527-9 with the replacement CPC and the test CPC. Any help is appreciated.

527-9 is a parameter for cruise control switches, they should be hard wired. Same with 2049-9 Reflash you CPC with OEM spes, first make sure you have any customer set parameters saved. Or you can compare parameters using DL.

Anyway they unplugged what they thought was an EEC, turns out they unplugged the "Star Point" connector, it had the same effect and it cleared the 2049-9 code.
