#### **Condition**

#### **Customer states:**

- The tire pressures in the instrument cluster are shown in metric (kPA).
- Changing the measurement units in the MMI settings menu has no effect.

## **Technical Background**

A problem in the configuration of the instrument cluster during production causes the measurement unit setting to be inoperable and display the wrong units.

#### **Production Solution**

New Target Data Container (ZDC) update in the instrument cluster control module, J285 (address word 0017) addressed the condition.
