SUBJECT:

Passenger Seatbelt Reminder Active Without Occupant

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves replacing the passenger seat cushion and occupant detection sensor.

MODELS:

2020 (M7) Jeep Compass

- NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: EMEA.
- NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after January 23, 2020 (MDH 0123XX) and on or before August 07, 2020 (MDH 0807XX).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may describe the following:

• Passenger seat belt reminder warning is illuminated without an occupant in the seat.

INSPECTION:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the repair. If any vehicle not on the VIN list exhibits the symptom/condition, perform the inspection diagnosis.

- 1. Put the passenger front seat in the full rearward position (Fig. 1) .
- 2. Disconnect frontal cushion plastic profile J-hook with hands (Fig. 1) .

- 3. Lift right seat cushion to check padding (Fig. 2) .
- 4. Insert your hand in the space between the padding and the metal structure, and check that the central padding is free of foam protrusions (Fig. 2).

5. Are foam protrusions felt in a north south direction on the central padding (Fig. 3) ?

- YES>>> Proceed to Step 1 of the Repair Procedure.
- NO>>> Seat protrusions are going in an east and west direction (Fig. 4) . Proceed to Step 6.

- 6. Re-position the cushion on the frame (Fig. 5) .
- 7. Connect frontal cushion plastic profile J-hook (Fig. 5) . This bulletin has been completed, use inspect LOP (23-20-36-97) to close the active RRT.

- 1. Remove and replace the passenger front seat cushion. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerConnect> Service Library under: Service Info> 23 Body / Seats, First Row / Cover, Seat Cushion, Front / Removal and Installation.
- NOTE: While the cushion is off replace the occupant detection sensor. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerConnect> Service Library under: Service Info>10 Restraints / Sensor, Occupant Detection / Removal and Installation.
