
If you encounter a vehicle that is experiencing an engine oil leak from the front of the engine proceed with the following.


Remove all residual oil from the front of the engine, add oil dye and allow the engine to run until a leak is observed.

Once a leak has been observed inspect the front of the engine Cam Carrier T joint area for potential source of the oil leak.

If the oil leak has been isolated to the Cam Carrier T joint area refer to the latest Service Information for resealing the Cam Carrier Assembly.

Pictures below show the Cam Carrier T joint area using a black light to highlight the oil dye.
