**Symptom/Vehicle Issue:** Center Console Side Trim Poor Fit Or Warped Appearance

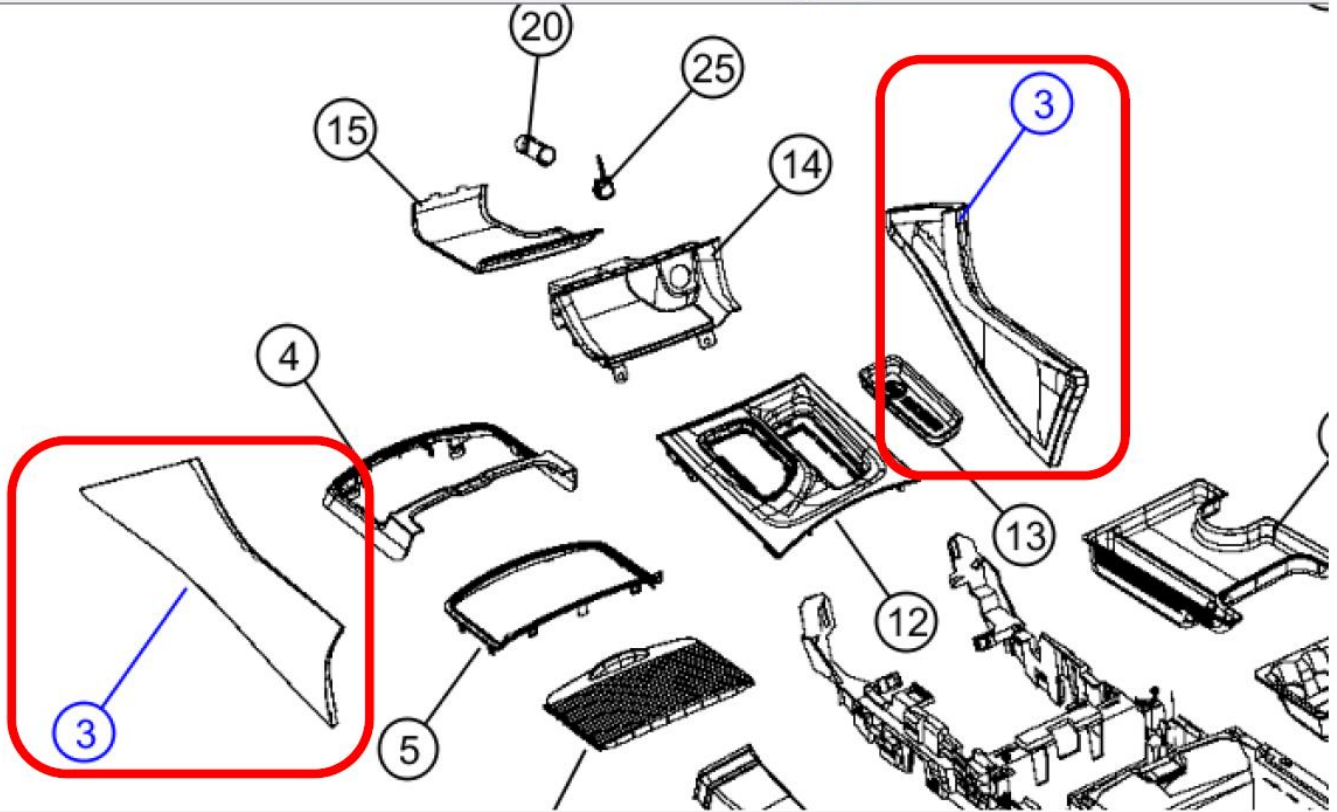
**Discussion:** Center console side panels may have an appearance of being warped due to not being fully snapped in place. Prior to replacing them remove and reinstall the panels to see if the fit improves. The panels have several metal retention clips that may not have been fully seated. Use a trim stick or carefully using a hand tool to release the clip(s). See images below. Note the clip locations on the part to aid in removal and reassembly.
