



Service Procedure


Additional Air Cleaner Element Bracket Service





Important: When removing the air cleaner element, care should be taken not to damage the bracket mount. Follow the instructions on the bracket for air filter removal.

- 1. Remove the air cleaner housing.
- 2. Remove the air cleaner element.



- 3. Squeeze the tabs (1) to release the bracket from the mount.
- 4. Slide the air filter away from the intake duct.
- 5. Using care, lift the bracket away from the mount and remove the air cleaner.



- 6. Align the new air cleaner to the air cleaner housing intake duct.
- 7. Align the bracket (1) to the mount (2).
- 8. Using care, slide the air cleaner and bracket rearwards till an audible click can be heard.

Note: A properly installed air cleaner should not fall out of the housing when turned over and shaken slightly.

- 9. Inspect the air cleaner for proper seal around the inlet duct.
- 10. Install the air cleaner housing.
