- The concern can be reproduced.
- In both light control modules (left and right), J1018 and J1023 (address word 00D6 and 00D7) there are no relevant DTCs logged.

Technical Background

The software needs to be updated.

Production Solution

New software in the vehicle electrical system control module, J519 (address word 0009) addressed the condition.

This TSB only applies, if there are no relevant DTCs logged in **both** light control modules (left and right), J1018 and J1023 (address word 00D6 and 00D7) about the static cornering lighting.
