Condition

Customer states:

When making adjustments to the rear HVAC system on the rear A/C display control head E265 it is not
possible to switch off the rear HVAC system using the "off" button. The HVAC system can, however, still be
switched off using the front HVAC controls.

Workshop findings:

• No relevant DTCs are stored.

Technical Background

The current software level in the electronic central control module (BCM 1), J519 (address word 0009) address blocks the "off" button input from the rear HVAC control.

Production Solution

New software in the electronic central control module (BCM 1), J519 (address word 0009) has been implemented in production.

To prevent charging of the high-voltage battery during the software update, the high-voltage cable is to be removed BEFORE entry of the SVM code on vehicles with high-voltage components. Charging the high-voltage battery during a software update can lead to damage of the high-voltage components.

SVM Update Instructions

- 1. Follow all instructions in TSB 2011732: 00 Software Version Management (SVM), operating instructions.
- 2. Update the electronic central control module (BCM 1), J519 (address word 0009) using the SVM action code as listed in the table below, if necessary:
