Fault Code 96/13 Fuel Tank Level Sensor stuck in position May 27, 2020 3:36 PM

I have approx. 24 units that we have sold to customers that are experiencing this fault. There is no effect on performance, fuel gauge and data star both read accurately when this fault is active. This code comes up randomly and will stay active until driver keys off and then back on. VIN LX1888 we have replaced sender, RX module, the harness from the fuel tank sender, pins on connectors, test CPC & MCM. Our best run with this was at the end of March when the code did not come back for 6 weeks after we reset the software to factory settings, but has been coming back now several times a week since 2nd week of May. Now I have been hearing of more and more units with this complaint. I am beginning to think this is a ghost code and there might be a software glitch.

Has anyone else had this issue in their shops?
