We are seeing a huge problem with multiple branches of our dealership where DL8 is only connecting to powertrain devices and wont connect to anything truck side. It seems to be spreading with laptops that were connecting this morning are no longer connecting. DL8 versions are the same between laptops connecting and ones that are not. Is anyone else seeing this issue? Version is 8.12SP2-04527-00028

EDIT: DL8 software support was called and they are aware of the issue. This is caused by the d20m8 recall and they are working on a fix. Hopefully to be fixed today or tomorrow.

would get a "not responding" message on diagnostic link and it would freeze up and shut itself down

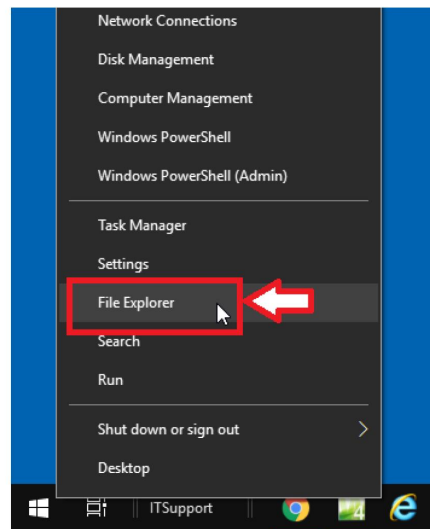
This came from our tech guy and I have tested that it does work. Follow the steps and DL8 will now connect to the truck side.

How To Resolve The 'CGM Software Not Supported' Error In Diagnostic Link

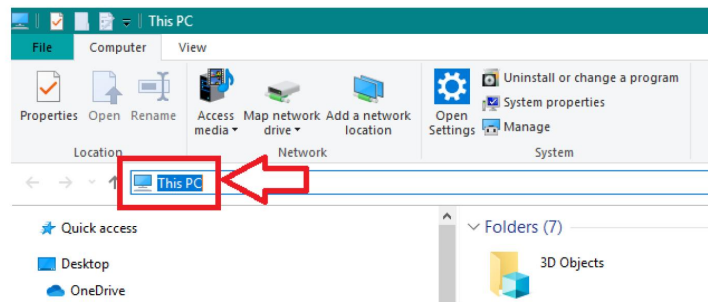
- 1) Close Diagnostic Link.
- 2) Highlight and copy this address:

***C:\ProgramData\Detroit Diesel\Drumroll\Application Data\Caesar\cbf***

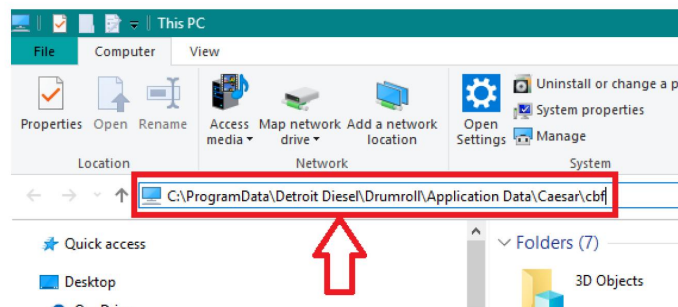
- 3) Right-click on the Windows Start menu and then select 'File Explorer' from the pop-up menu:



- 4) At the File Explorer window, click in the address bar to highlight the address (I.E. This PC):



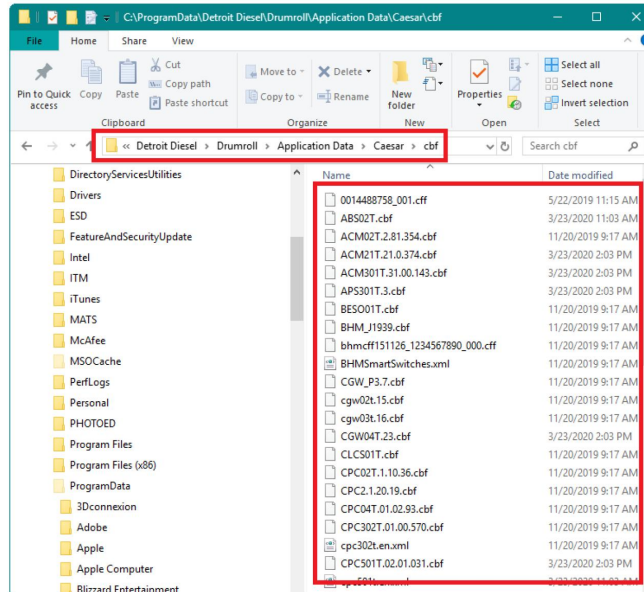
- 5) Press <CTRL><V> to paste the address from step #2 into the address bar:



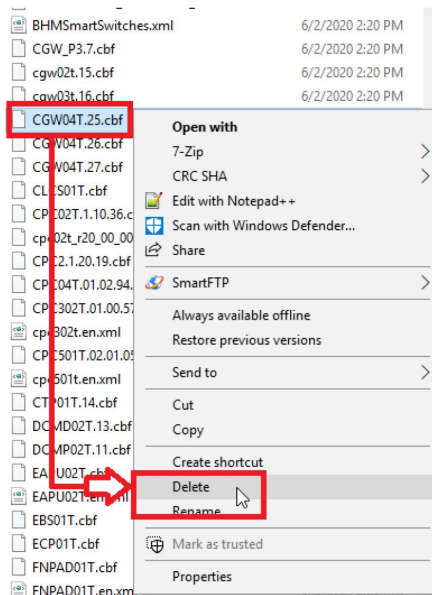

6) Press <ENTER>.

\* You will be brought to the location of the Diagnostic Link 'CBF' files:



7) Right-click on each 'CBF' file beginning with 'CGW04T', except the 'CGW04T.26.CBF' file, and then select 'Delete' from the drop-down menu:



8) Launch DiagnosticLink.
