I found there are soft and hard mounts for a DD13. I'm kind of curious if they make hard mounts for the DD16. The DD13 mounts had an annotation that if the unit was a logger to use harder mounts. The mounts in the DD16 might already be hard but I'm having a hard time finding information on them.

Found out there has been other failures on right side mounts on dd16 high torque engines, theory is that it is exhaust temp causing premature failure , so we wrapped the exhaust to keep the heat away from mount area will have to see if this helps
