Symptom in Vehicle Interior (Surround View) - Vehicle is Shown Offset: Re-Programming Central Computer Using SD Card (SY 138/20)

Model Line:	Macan (95B) Cayenne (92A)	
Model Year:	As of 2016 up to 2018	
Subject:	Central computer (PCM 4.0)	
Equipment:	Front and reversing camera system (I-no. KA6)	
Symptom:	When Surround View is active, the vehicle is shown offset/enlarged in the 'Panorama Front' and 'Panorama Top' view.	
Cause:	This fault type can occur due to defective software in the central computer.	
Remedial Action:	In the event of a customer complaint, re-program the central computer using an SD card, see \Rightarrow <i>Workshop Manual '915225 Programming central computer data update'</i> .
