Condition	Some customers may comment on a loss of power steering assist and a Steering Effort Reduced message displayed on the DIC. This occurs during track events in extreme heat.			
Cause	This may be caused by reduced air flow around the power steering gear during extreme track temperatures.			
Correction	Install Power Steering Deflectors for track use only. Follow the installation instructions included with the deflector kit.  The contents of the deflector kit are shown in the graphic below: Right (1) and left (2) Deflectors, and left (3) and right (4) Shield Supports.			

#### Important:

- Keep the two side shields and side shield screws so the side shields can be reinstalled after track use. The remaining fasteners will be used to attach the deflectors and shield retainers.
- Before driving on public roads, the deflectors should be removed and the original shields should be reinstalled.
- · Installation time is approximately 10 minutes with the vehicle on a hoist.
