I did check the cab ground connector near steering shaft for seated pins and good crimp....Has fault MQ switch bus malfunction....520197 mode31....no troubleshooting for fault. any clues?

We had a unit with intermitten issue. Lights would start flashing, window controls stop working, and ac blower would stop working. Issue would happen randomly. All of these run on the same can. We could never get it to happen in shop. It all kept pointing to star point or cgw. We raplaced both and still happened. Finally happened

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in the shop. Unplugged the park smart from the star point and everything went back to normal. Found bolt for the cabinet going through the can wires for the park smart. Some times just unplugging everything on the same can will help narrow it down. Sounds crazy but park smart wire made lights, windows, and front blower all go nuts.
