Some 2021MY Seltos (SP2), K5 (DL3A) and Sorento (MQ4a, MQ4 KH) models are equipped with a new Auto-Shut Off feature, which automatically shuts off the engine after a set time period. This feature will help reduce fuel consumption and prevent carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning.

For the Auto-Shut Off feature to be activated, the vehicle must meet certain prerequisites conditions.

- Prerequisite Conditions
 - 1. Ignition ON and engine running
 - 2. Transmission is in the P (Park) position
 - 3. The driver's seat belt is unfastened
 - 4. The driver's door is opened
 - 5. The passenger seat is not occupied
- Auto-Shut Off Settings

The driver may set the vehicle's shut-off timer to 60 min., 30 min., <u>or</u> Disable. Depending on the model, the settings can be changed by way of the instrument cluster display (User Settings \rightarrow Convenience) or the (AVN) head unit, if equipped.

***** NOTICE

The default setting will be retained until the timer is reset. <u>The timer will revert back to</u> <u>the previous setting at the next startup</u> even if the driver had previously selected 'Disable' in the User Settings mode.
