

Removing The Password From A V-MAC III Vehicle



> Internal Content

Refer to the two most common passwords below.

1. Customer Password if unknown can be cleared by reprogramming the data file. Select Erase Both Vehicle And Customer Passwords from drop down box - Select Reason For Reprogramming.

If reprogramming the data file does not work, reprogram ECU software and program ECU data file without a read and save.

NOTE: All of the vehicle data and customer data will have to be entered.

2. Fleet Protection password protects fleet trucks by using special restrictive data files and or CDS (Custom Defined Script). If the unit is no longer owned by the original fleet or company the data files must be changed and CDS file removed, this can only be done by Tech Support.

NOTE: Reprogramming software and programming data files will not work with number 2. The unit data files and CDS files are changed in V-MAC online 1st data files are usually in both ECU's (EECU, VECU).
