Technical Background

Exterior heated mirror(s) inoperative when ambient conditions are correct for operation. GFF may show no related stored faults.

Service

- Install a battery maintainer on vehicle.
- Make certain the ODIS scan tool is updated to the latest level.

Under special functions tab:

• Run the ctrl module software configuration test plan on -*J386*- Drivers Door Control Module Electronics, address word 42.

Once test plan is finished:

Clear any related faults, cycle the ignition and retest operation of the exterior heated mirror.

Additional verification of operation can be viewed in Measured Value Block information for -*J*386-, address word 42 for Mirror heater> Operating condition "active" & performance percentage reading "100%".

If concerns remain for the right exterior mirror:

Repeat the test plan procedure on -J387- Front Passenger Door Control Module Electronics address word 52.
