Technical Background

In model year 2021 vehicles equipped with new MQB3 radios, SiriusXM has broadened the service functionality to include SiriusXM with 360L services. This is a satellite and internet service allowing for more features and customizable functions within the vehicle.

In order for these radios to have full functionality, the customer will need to enroll into Car-Net®. If this does not happen, the radio will have functions "greyed out" not allowing the customer to receive the features/functionality. The radios would show satellite only channels and features.



Note:

These radios <u>do not</u> need to be removed or claimed as warranty replacement. The customer simply needs to enroll into Car-Net® for all services to work properly.

How to determine if 360L is not working due to missing Car-Net® enrollment:

Now Playing Screen



- Tune to SXM Hits 1 (Channel 2).
- Look for a globe to the left of the time in the HMI screen.
- Normally the globe shown in the red box above is bright white. If it is draft grey or does not appear, then the Car-Net® modem is not enrolled/connected.
