This is my first New Cascadia that I review. This has a problem that when giving contact, an SRS fault message appears on the instrument panel. It appears for a few intact and then disappears, leaving no record of breakdowns in DL and instrument panel.

Any advice?

Vehicle has 16,450 thousand and date of entry into service 01/18/2019.

Monitor it with D/L open in the Fault Code Tab. Then run that test you showed again. But all the ICU shows is Driver's Air Bag Error Detected.

When you said "contact" is that what I call key on?

Your caution message is momentary. When the message goes away the code that made the message is inactive. The ICU Diagnostics screen will only show active error codes. To view inactive codes you will need to do like Talbert said, connect to the vehicle with Diagnostic Link.

I have seen that momentary SRS message at key on when battery voltage is low. I did not look for codes because key on was the only time the message came on. My suspicion was the low battery voltage caused the SRS module to boot up slower than expected but once it did boot up the message went away.
