Discussion: Hoist the vehicle and Inspect front coil springs for creating noise due to bowing and contacting strut dust shield (fig 1).

If the spring is significantly bowed and or contacting the strut dust boot, remove the strut from the vehicle. Follow removal procedure 02 - Front Suspension / Front / SPRING, Front Coil / Removal. Using service information procedure 02 - Front Suspension / Front / SPRING, Front Coil / Installation reassemble the strut with the coil positioned to match the isolator. If the spring is still significantly bowed after the adjustment replace the coil spring. Note most vehicles will be resolved with repositioning the spring.
