Is this a common issue with a TSB or is it just us? we have been ordering and replacing air pressure switches. not sure yet if this fixes the issue because I did not personally diagnose and repair it.

I personally haven't had a bad switch yet but I've had spread pins at the SSAM, spread pins at the switch and one was a parameter issue.
