

Back up camera packages for our Saf-T-Liner C2 are changing to incorporate new supplier parts replacing discontinuing hardware and to provide solutions for future product feature development and standards at TBB. These changes introduce length specific harnesses, a standard rear facing camera mounting location and a new camera capable of a wider field of view. This release will relocate the back up camera from its current position to a mounting point integrated at the upper marker lights on the rear cap.

New hardware provides higher equipment capabilities, resolves option conflicts and satisfies greater vehicle standards

- New Camera
 - Meets visibility requirements for rearview camera display per FMVSS 111
 - 10% wider field of view increasing the viewing area for a safer driver experience
 - Locked camera angle that has established the best position for school bus application
- Mounting Bracket
 - Standardizes installation processes and mounting hardware for all rear facing camera options
- Body length driven harnessing streamlines the installation process and eliminates manual connections
- Relocated mounting position allows more flexibility with rear cap mounted signage

This change introduces new length related sales codes for harness requirements. These codes will be applied through configurator rules when selecting from Interior Backing Monitor options D602200007 or D602200008. Changes in list prices for these options reflect material cost impacts. This change will be implemented on uncommitted quotes beginning on 3/19/2020.
