Concerns: Screws on front side member

Information: There is a possibility that a screw on the front side member was not tightened to the prescribed

tightening torque on the affected vehicles.

As a result, the screw can become loose while driving, resulting in noises from around the body front

section.

Action Tighten fastening screws on the side member to the prescribed tightening torque.





If a fastening screw is missing, first check whether it is **underneath** the luggage compartment trim panel and screw it in and tighten it again if necessary. If the fastening screw is not in the luggage compartment, screw in and tighten a new fastening screw.
