


Figure 1. Privacy pop up.

- After software update, with active privacy settings, e.g. "Use of vehicle position", the pop-up window is shown with every ignition cycle (Figure 1).
- If "Do not show again" is chosen, the message is nevertheless shown again with every restart/ignition cycle.

### **Technical Background**

Due to a software issue, the message pops up whenever a privacy setting is selected and does not store the "do not show again" feature.

The privacy settings themselves are not affected by this pop up.

### **Production Solution**

#### **Service**

- 1. Explain to the customer that a solution is forthcoming for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2021 and that no repairs are necessary at this point. Do not replace any components for this condition since this will not resolve the customer's concern.
