IMC 20C1 Update

- 20C1 was launched to resolve an issue with Apple Car
 Play & Android Auto tiles appearing on non-applicable
 vehicles.
- The 20C1 IMC update was available via TOPIx on Jan 4,
 2020 and supersedes the previous 20C update.
- The 20C1 IMC update will be launched direct to customers by Jan 15.

TCU v19.2 via SOTA

- A customer campaign was launched on Nov 5th for any vehicle that meets the minimum requirements.
- Retailers can perform a fix on fail update for any vehicle not included in the customer campaign.
- To date 13,774 vehicles have successfully updated TCU via SOTA.

L663 Multi-ECU SOTA Update (OS 2.0.6)

- The L663 Multi-ECU SOTA (OS 2.0.6) update was launched on December 4th and has been successfully installed on 4,939 L663 Defenders
- Updates: ABS, DADC, IPMA, ICCM, IGM, PSCM, & CCM

L663 Multi-ECU SOTA Update (OS 2.0.7) CHCM, GWM, SODL, SODR

- There have been 5 reported cases of customer's experiencing a no-start condition after completing the update due to an issue with the Gateway Module (GWM).
- 4 out of 5 cars were recovered via a manual patch on Pathfinder to re-write the GWM software.
- Currently this issue is under investigation, please ensure a TA is raised if there are any additional cases.
