Customer states:

• The message "The software update could not be downloaded..." is displayed on the wireless control head (Figure 1).

Technical Background

A software malfunction in MIB3 vehicles causes the message to be displayed erroneously.

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Production Solution

Service

This TSB replaces Pending Service Solution (PSS) TSB 2061670: PSS 91 Rear MMI control panel (SCON) shows the message: "software update could not be downloaded.

 Download the update file from ServiceNet: https://www.accessaudi.com/snetlijct/web/audi/audi-mmiscripts (Audi A8 MIB3 SCON Repair Script) (Figure 2).



You need to be logged into Service Net for the QR code to take you to the location.

- 2. Extract the downloaded file onto a FAT32 formatted USB flash drive.
- 3. Turn on the vehicle's ignition and wait for the MMI system to be fully booted up.
- Insert the USB flash drive created in step 2 into the vehicle's USB port. The script should start running automatically.
- 5. After the script has completed execution, remove the USB flash drive from the USB port.
- 6. Turn off the vehicle and await a bus sleep cycle.
- 7. In some cases, the SCON has to be restarted. Please perform the reset by pressing the "Volume Down" button for at least 20 seconds.
