THE PARMETER FOR WASHER FLUID LEVEL IS ALSO DISABLED ALREADY. HAS ANYONE ELSE SEEN THIS?

I have not had that complaint and did not find any related bulletins.. G06-90882-001 shows the washer level wire 320a that your VIN shouldn't have. Your VIN has -000, no fluid level circuit.. 320a would connect to sSAM connector x8 cavity14 if you had it. Might verify it is not there. Logic would tell me the sSAM should ignore it, with the parameter you have, if it had the wire and it shorted to ground, but I can't say that for certain. The sSAM chart says it is AL (Active low) - Signal will activate when it is connected to ground.

Might make sure the sSAM power feeds and ground are clean. The sSAM has had other symptoms caused by too much gunk on those loop connectors. ref [SS 1034884 P4 New Cascadia Unintended Dome Lamp Activation Due To Poor Connections at the sSAM](#).
