DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit a squeaking noise from front brakes when braking after sitting in cold and moist weather. Due to an increase in the resistance of the pads under cold conditions, the pads easily vibrate, causing the squeak noise.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Replace the guide plates with the modified ones.
- 3. Verify the repair.
