Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Squeak Noise From Exterior Door Handle

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation:

Lifting the door handle causes a squeak noise.

Discussion:

Replacement of the door handle assembly is not necessary. Applying lubrication to the handle mechanism should resolve the customer complaint.

Follow the Service Library handle removal procedure- 23 - Body / Doors - Front or Rear HANDLE, Exterior / Removal. Apply Mopar grease 05083150AA to the bell crank screw/washer (Fig 1). Optional lubricant is Mopar 05019059AC. Work the grease into the screw area by lifting handle several times while handle is off the car. Reinstall the handle(s) following 23 - Body / Doors - Front or Rear / HANDLE, Exterior / Installation.
