SUBJECT:

Red Chrysler Inlay In The Rear Liftgate Wing Badge Lifting Off

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves inspecting the red Chrysler inlay in the wing badge on the rear liftgate and replacing the emblem if necessary.

MODELS:

2020 (RU) Chrysler Pacifica

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: North America.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after November 20, 2019 (MDH 1120XX) or on or before November 26, 2019 (MDH 1126XX) equipped with a Red Badging (Sales Code M34).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may notice the following:

• The red Chrysler inlay in the wing badge on the rear liftgate is peeling or lifting off.

DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the perform the inspection procedure. This RRT only applies to vehicles on the RRT VIN list.

- 1. Inspect the red Chrysler inlay in the wing badge on the rear liftgate.
- 2. Was the red inlay on the wing badge peeling or lifting (Fig. 1)?
 - YES>>> Proceed to Step 1 of the Repair Procedure.
 - NO>>> This bulletin has been completed, use inspection LOP (23-03-08-9M) to close the active RRT.



Red CHRYSLER Inlay Peeling Or Lifting Off Emblem

PARTS REQUIRED:

Qty.	Part No.	Description
1 (AR)	68545452AA	Emblem (Chrysler Wing)

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

CAUTION! Do not exceed 52° C (120° F) when heating the wing badge emblem. Failure to comply may result in damage to the vehicle and/or the vehicle paint finish.

1. Replace the wing badge emblem. Using a heat gun, heat the badge emblem.

NOTE: Additional heat may be need to be applied while prying the wing badge emblem away from the lamp bar/exterior handle assembly.

- 2. Using a trim stick, gently pry the wing badge emblem away from the wing badge lamp bar/exterior handle assembly.
- 3. Thoroughly clean all residue from the wing badge emblem attachment area by wiping the area with a clean lint-free cloth, moistened with a 50% solution of water and alcohol. Wipe dry the area immediately with a dry lint-free cloth.
- 4. Remove the protective covering from the back of the wing badge emblem and firmly press the emblem onto the wing badge lamp bar/exterior handle assembly.
