- 3: Is the door opened during or while the mirror(s) is/are dipped?
- 4: Does it happen when unlocking the car and the mirror/-s is/are in incorrect position? Both mirrors or left or right?
- 5: Does the memory function put the mirrors into correct position? Either when working as they should or as it should and/or when the fault is active?
- 6: Is the symptom replicable?
