

Be aware that the fuses removed at the factory have been changed.



(1) Relay and Fuse block

The fuses removed from the relay and fuse block (1) are as follows:

- Previous Room (15A), Audio1 (15A)
- New□Room (25A), BOSE (25A)

NOTE: The new BOSE fuse is in the same location as the previous Audio1 fuse.

Previous CX-5
Insert 15A fuses in the ROOM / AUDIO locations.


CX-5 Vehicles with 10.25" center display Insert 25A fuses in the ROOM / BOSE locations. NOTE: Without the BOSE fuse inserted, MAZDA CONNECT will not operate.







