Intermittently, the theft alarm triggers (horn sounds and lights flash) when one of the following occur:

- Using the lock, unlock, or trunk open function on the Intelligent Key
- Pushing a handle request switch (door or trunk)
- Opening a door or the trunk with the vehicle unlocked

### and

CONSULT-III plus (C-III plus) shows the last item to trigger the theft alarm is BATTERY.

Refer to Check Last Item to Trigger Theft Alarm on the next page.

# ACTION

Replace the Body Control Module (BCM).

- Refer to the Electronic Service Manual, section BCS-Body Control Systems, for replacement information.
- Use the **new** BCM listed in the PARTS INFORMATION section. •

#### Check Last Item to Trigger Theft Alarm

- 1. Turn the ignition ON, engine OFF / not Ready.
- 2. Connect the plus VI and start C-III plus.
- 3. Navigate the C-III plus to the screen shown in Figure 1.
  - Diagnosis (One System) or Diagnosis (All Systems) and then BCM.
- 4. Select THEFT ALM.
