Condition

Costumer states:

· The steering warning lamp is on.

Workshop findings:

The following DTC is stored (sporadically or statically) in the rear axle steering control module, J1019 (address word 00CB):

• DTC B200FF0 (internal malfunction) with symptom code 251.

Technical Background

The internal monitoring function in the control module responds prematurely.

Production Solution

Improved software is under development.

Service

Proceed as follows:

- **Option 1:** Passive/sporadic entry: Delete the DTC and release the vehicle.
- **Option 2:** Active/static entry: Perform the rear steering basic settings in the self-diagnosis of the control module.
 - A login code is necessary for this procedure: Code 20103.
 - · Afterward, release the vehicle.



This procedure must only be used for the symptom code 251 as specified above.
