Condition	If the vehicle is left parked and running with the RKE transmitter inside the vehicle, it will continue to run for up to an hour				
Cause	The cause of the condition may be some GM vehicles were designed with an idle time-out.				
	In certain situations, the customer will request that this feature be turned off because they need to extend their idle time.				
Correction	A calibration for the Body Control Module is available to eliminate the idle time out feature. The Techline Customer Support Center will provide programming instructions and changes to the vehicles calibration settings. You must provide the vehicle identification number (VIN) of the vehicle to be programmed. There is a fee associated with the requested vehicle calibration changes.

## **Owner's Agreement Statement**

When the vehicle was produced, it came with the auto-shutdown feature enabled. If you are not the primary owner of your vehicle, please note that this feature may have been disabled by a previous owner. The vehicle owner is responsible for being aware of and complying with any local ordinances that may

restrict prolonged idling. The vehicle owner can have this feature re-enabled at owner cost at any GM service center
