- The HomeLink Garage Door Opener (furthermore abbreviated as UGDO) shortcut button in the MMI dropdown menu is grayed out while driving (Figure 1).
- A message "For your safety, this function is not available while driving" is displayed when "clicking" on it.

 The geolocation feature of the UGDO system is not working, despite having been stored by the customer during the pairing procedure (Figure 2).

A software bug in the MIB3 system causes the non-availability of the hotkey and geolocation features of the UGDO system.
