Trailer Plug Wiring Configuration

Altec is committed to providing our customers safe and reliable products from initial delivery throughout the useful life of the machine.

You may have received a unit with a trailer plug wiring configuration that was specified in the purchase order to supply a constant 12+ volts to pin 6. If you intend to pull a trailer that is configured with pin 6 as the trailer brakes, a wiring change may be needed.

This letter is a notification stating the trailer plug wiring specification included in the purchase order. Ensure that you check the trailer brake operation as part of the pre-trip inspection to ensure that the trailer brakes are operating properly. Altec does not require the truck-mounted trailer plug be rewired, but it may be necessary depending on the trailer the customer intends to pull.
