Concerns: Porsche Communication Management (PCM) 4.1

Information: Due to an expired service contract, the 'Satellite/ Google Earth map' function is no longer

available on vehicles that do not have the latest PCM software.

Action required: In the event of a customer complaint, perform PCM update, see  $\Rightarrow$  Workshop Manual '915225

Programming central computer data update'.
