M2 with On Lane, On Guard has problem where the radio will cut out after the rumble strip sound for lane departure. At times there was a long delay before the radio would come back on. A few other times, the radio would not come back on at all without a key cycle or vehicle sat key off for several minutes. There is very little service information on M2, most of the information is for Assurance or P4 Cascadia. Got help from CSC with this issue and found there is a failure of the audio interrupt switches. p/n: PFC PP607069. I checked the wiring for the radio and it mentions "audio interrupt switch" but doesn't give a whole lot of information. Ref A06-95550-002 for camera. D66-08463-000 for the switches. G66-03134-001 for the wiring. Also information is in BOM 73F and 74D. Since I worked on this one, we have another truck with complaint of "no sound out of speakers" even though the radio worked correctly. The rumble strip would sound at key on, but there was never radio sound out of the speakers. On this unit, the audio interrupt switches kept the speakers off all the time. Switches are center of the dash, up top, directly behind the HVAC duct to the right of the radio. The top of the dash has to be removed to access. Look for the yellow tape.

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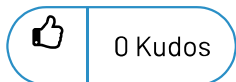
