Title: CV Wide Body Trucks with Poor Visibility in the Side View Door Mirrors

Applies To: CV series with 96" - 102" wide body installed and built prior to 2022 model year.

DESCRIPTION

This document will guide the user through identifying and changing the side door mirrors to the wide body mirrors that are sized for either a 96" or 102" wide body that was installed on a CV build prior to 2022 Model Year. The CVs built prior to the 2022 model year did not have wide body mirror options available. The new wide body mirror options were made available starting with the 2022 model year and the service parts were made available in the PDCs starting in March 2021.

SYMPTOM(s)

Diagnostic Trouble Code(s) & Dashboard Indicator Light(s): Not Applicable

Customer Observations or Concerns:

Driver cannot see around the wide body in the side-view door mirrors regardless of adjustment or extending arm. Prior to the 2022 model year trucks that had 96"-102" bodies added had poor to no visibility through the side-view door mirrors. This was due to no orderable wide body mirror options for the CV series.

SPECIAL TOOL(s) / SOFTWARE

No special tools or software is required to remove and/or install replacement door mirrors.

SERVICE PARTS INFORMATION

NOTE: All mirror options will have the same mounting style/footprint, wiring connector style, and hardware to install.

NOTE: When changing mirror part number/size be sure to select the mirror that has the same features as the original mirror. Power/Heater/Turn Signal Lights, etc... If the truck was not built with power mirrors the wider mirror selected should not be power. The replacement mirror should have similar features as the original mirror. Note that some options are limited in the wide body mirrors.
