#### When a new VIN plate or B-Pillar Safety Certification label is required:

- 1. Save all VIN plates and/or B-Pillar Safety Certification labels removed from the vehicle until the new VIN plate or label arrives.
- 2. On the Access Audi web site.



## Technical Service Bulletin

- Expand either the Parts menu or Service menu, then select the Compliance Label Ordering Portal.
- 4. Enter the VIN into Quick VIN Order or the VIN-Specific Items tab of the Order form.
- Select the desired label.
- 6. When requested, enter the weight information from the original B-Pillar Safety Certification label. This information will be required to complete the web-based form.
  - The completed web-based form will be electronically routed to the Compliance Label Coordinator for approval.
  - The Compliance Label Coordinator will take the necessary steps to fulfill the request.
  - Once the VIN plate and/or Safety Certification label is received from Audi AG, the Compliance Label Coordinator will provide the label to the dealer.
