ATTENTION: ALL DEALER PARTS & SERVICE MANAGERS

Kia America, Inc., is extending the New Vehicle Limited Warranty coverage for the multi-function switch assembly for all 2015-2016 MY Sedona vehicles from 5 years/60,000 miles to 15 years/unlimited miles, starting from the date the vehicle was first put into service. The multi-function switch assembly is the steering column-mounted stalk that controls headlamps and tail lamps, turn signals, and, if equipped, fog lamps. This warranty extension is to address any concerns with the functionality of the multi-function switch assembly at no cost to the customers (does not include replacement of bulbs due to normal wear).

If, at any time during the extended warranty coverage, the customer's vehicle exhibits issues with headlamps, tail lamps, turn signals, and/or fog lamps, Kia authorizes its dealers to diagnose and, if the multi-function switch assembly must be replaced, it will be covered at Kia's expense at no cost to the customer. Please note the normal wear of bulbs is not covered under this warranty coverage.

This is NOT a service campaign that requires mandatory repair for all eligible vehicles. Unless the vehicle's multi-function switch assembly does not function properly, dealers should not replace any component under this warranty extension program.

PARTS INFORMATION: Expected replacement needs for SWITCH ASSY-MULTIFUN are expected to be low. Please order only as needed.

NOTE: This supplement to Kia's New Vehicle Limited Warranty does not alter the limitations and exclusions contained in that New Vehicle Limited Warranty including failure of the multi-function switch due to abuse, neglect, or external damage to the related components.

The Technical Service Bulletin that provides vehicle repair procedures will be posted on the Kia Global Information System (KGIS) at www.kiatechinfo.com, and the Warranty Bulletin describing this warranty extension will be posted on kdealer.com during the week of **July 7, 2021**.

OWNER NOTIFICATION

Kia will notify owners advising them of the warranty extension program on **July 9, 2021**. Note that owners who have incurred expenses to remedy this issue prior to the date of this notice may have the opportunity to obtain reimbursement for that expense by mailing the Request for Reimbursement Form along with their documentation to Kia for review and consideration.

LEGAL PRIVACY LIABILITY NOTICE: Pursuant to the terms of the Dealer Sales and Service Agreement and the Gramm-Leach-Bliley federal consumer privacy act, you are required to keep confidential any and all information and documents provided to you by Kia America, Inc. or generated by you in the conduct of carrying out work under that Agreement regarding Kia vehicle purchasers and owners, including but not limited to warranty claim information. Kia dealers may use such owner information for the sole purpose of conducting and performing this safety recall campaign, and for no other purpose.
