

2019-2021 Mazda3 2020-2021 CX-30

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit water leaking into the passenger compartment from the rear door through the bottom of the service hole behind the rear door trim during rain or when washing the vehicle.



This is caused by one of the following:

- Since the material of the seal rubber is not resistant to surfactants, the rubber deteriorates when the vehicle is washed and allows water to penetrate into the seal rubber of the service hole cover.
- The lower tabs of the service hole cover may not have been completely engaged at the factory.

To eliminate this concern, the service-hole cover has been modified.

NOTE: It is a tentative change.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.



REPAIR PROCEDURE



- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Remove the service hole covers from the REAR DOOR LATCH AND LOCK ACTUATOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION procedure on MGSS and replace with new ones, using the following steps when installing.
 - Mazda3 (REAR DOOR LATCH AND LOCK ACTUATOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION)
 - CX-30 (REAR DOOR LATCH AND LOCK ACTUATOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION)

There are 2 types of new covers: modified service-hole covers and non-modified ones. Images are for the left side door. Mazda3




Modified service-hole cover with seal material (1) B0J8-72-973 / B0J8-73-973




Non-modified service-hole covers BCJH-72-973E / BCJH-73-973E BDTS-72-973E / BDTS-73-973E


Repair procedure depends on the type of the obtained part.


- Modified service-hole cover with seal materials: Replace the service-hole cover with a modified one.
- Non-modified service-hole covers: Apply butyl tapes as follows.

NOTE: Butyl tape is applied to the service hole covers to help prevent the water from seeping through. The product to use is 3M - 08610 Round Ribbon Sealer. Contact the local 3M distributor and order (1) roll. One roll will repair 7 vehicles. a. Cut butyl tape to the following sizes:

NOTE: Use butyl tape with a width=1/4 in (6.4mm) and thickness=1/8 in (3.2mm).



b. Remove any oil/grease from the area highlighted in green (images shown are the left side door). Mazda3






c. Apply TAPE-1 (6) as per the green line below along with the seal rubber (5). **NOTE:**


- Using water on your hands will make working with the butyl tape easier as the tape will not stick to hands with water on them.
- Be careful not to apply TAPE-1 to the front part of the tabs as it is difficult to apply TAPE-1 near the tabs.
 - 1) Start applying TAPE-1 (6) at the edge (1) of the tab.
 - 2) Using the release paper (4), press the tape hard (2) to fill the gap (3) between TAPE-1 (6) and the seal rubber (5) / service hole cover (7).








CORRECT (image is of CX-30)

The butyl tape (2) IS sticking up at or above the height of seal rubber (1).






d. Apply TAPE-2 as per the blue line below.


NOTE:

Bulletin No.: 09-020/21

- DO NOT fill area (1) to avoid blocking the drain hole on the door panel.
- Apply TAPE-2 along the bottom edge of the ribs (2) of the tab.
- Make sure TAPE-1 and TAPE-2 make good contact with each other when they overlap.










Examples of NOT CORRECT placement of tapes (image is of CX-30)




- (3) TAPE-2 does not adhere to TAPE-1.
- (4) TAPE-2 is away from the tab.
- (5) TAPE-1 does not adhere to the seal rubber.


e. Press (1) the release paper (2) against TAPE-2 (5) to adhere the butyl tape to the service hole cover (4) [seal rubber (3)].
