SITUATION

- · Water sloshing noises coming from the rear passenger compartment (left or right) while driving
- · Water ingress in the luggage compartment, or in the rear passenger compartment-
 - rear seat bench
 - rear passenger compartment foot well
 - rear passenger compartment side panel
- Failure of various control units installed in the area of the water removal channel


CAUSE

Poor water drainage due to installation location of the rocker panel trim.

CORRECTION

Remove the drain outlet.

PROCEDURE



Remove the underbody paneling to access the water drain outlet shown to the left. Refer to repair instructions 51 71 017 "Removing and installing/replacing (left or right) underbody panelling".

Completely remove the drain and do not reinstall. Clean any residual debris from the underbody panelling.

PARTS INFORMATION

Parts are not required unless additional damage is present as a result of water blockages. Refer to ETK/AIR for parts depending on specific damage.

Covered under the terms of the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty for Passenger Cars and Light Trucks.
